All participants including players and coaches complete the NHS QR or online track and trace for government purposes. 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<p>Participants and Coaches</p> <p>Spectators</p> <p>Social Distancing</p> <p>Hygiene</p>	<p>Social distancing on arrival to sessions</p> <p>Gatherings around the 3G stadia</p> <p>Signage so players and coaches understand entry and exit points.</p> <p>Informing players to enter the 3G stadia designated places at the correct times.</p> <p>Players to remain in cars when arriving at the venue and enter the pitch at designated point and times set out, led by the coach.</p> <p>Informing players, they cannot mix with one another around the pitch area.</p> <p>A maximum of 30 participants including coaches at any one time in a hired area.</p> <p>Single/limited use of toilet facilities to avoid congestion in confined spaces.</p>	<p>Signage around the facility to increase awareness of social distancing.</p> <p>Spectators allowed into the stadia to view training activity for safeguarding purposes however social distancing and government gathering limits must be adhered to.</p> <p>Any spectator viewing training must arrive within 5 minutes of the session beginning and leave the stadia 5 minutes before the conclusion to reduce potential traffic of people.</p> <p>Designated meet points marked out outside the 3G stadia for drop off areas for each session.</p> <p>Designated collection areas for participants at the conclusion of each session- Back at meet points which would have been vacated, one-way system in place.</p>	<p>Training workers to promote compliance to facility users.</p> <p>Monitor effectiveness of procedures in place.</p> <p>Use website, social media platforms as well as basic communication to filter key messages.</p> <p>Controls put in place for any non-compliance.</p> <p>Potential briefings with players before activities</p>	<p>HCSA Staff and hirer</p>	<p>Immediately</p>	<p>Yes</p>

	<p>Ensure all players are up to date around sharing of equipment procedures.</p> <p>Equipment movement kept to a minimum.</p> <p>Informing players to retrieve the balls around the 3G with feet rather than hands.</p> <p>Informing players, they cannot be shouting or spitting at the session on the 3G.</p> <p>Players should all be aware of entry and exit procedures.</p> <p>Players being aware of procedure if they become infected after training.</p> <p>Coaches providing more regular hygiene breaks during sessions.</p>	<p>Radios provided for staff and coaches to communicate should any issues arise.</p> <p>Separate entry and exit gates on and off the pitch.</p> <p>Stadia gates closed during session, with fire exit gate left open at rear for people to use toilets during session.</p> <p>No new hirer, team or coach enters the 3G stadia until the session prior has concluded, a staff member to manage movement on and off between sessions.</p> <p>Signage displayed with limited numbers in confined spaces.</p> <p>No access to changing room facilities or indoor spaces during training.</p> <p>Any hirer, club or team hiring the 3G on a casual basis to be provided online/contactless payment option to reduce cash handling.</p>				
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
